# Comrades, Sisters And Brothers

I would like to thank all the volunteers that helped to put the flags out in tribute to our fallen Veterans. Also, thanks to all the post and Auxiliary members who stood out in the cool weather for the Veterans day parade and Buddy Poppy drive. This helps to get the post noticed in the local area.

Now that we are in December we need to start thinking about the upcoming Post Christmas Party and Dinner. We will need Volunteers for these two events. If you want to help or can provide items for these events, please get in touch with one of the Post officers.

I work at the Hampton National Cemetery. Since I have started there I have found that many

veterans are unaware of the burial benefits that are available to them. Our veterans and their spouses and minor children are eligible for a free burial plot and headstone in a national cemetery. Unfortunately, we are a "closed" cemetery, meaning that we do not actively hold interments. From time to time a gravesite is relinquished due to a veteran's spouse remarrying. That still doesn't leave a lot of promise for space here at our cemetery. Good news is that the state of Virginia operates a Veterans cemetery in Suffolk and the eligibility is exactly the same. The only difference is an administrative fee for spouse/ child.

I know this is not a benefit that most of us like to think about, but it can save our loved ones a lot of money. Click here for more info on burial benefits:

On the morning of January 12, 1943, the boys' father, Tom Sullivan, was preparing for work when three men in uniform – a lieutenant commander, a doctor and a chief petty officer – approached his door. "I have some news for you about your boys," the naval officer said. "Which one?" asked Tom. "I'm sorry," the officer replied. "All five."



U.S.S. Juneau (CL-52) sunk. The ship's crew numbered 820. There were 10 survivors.

## NOTARY PUBLIC

The following Post members are commissioned as Notary Public's in the Commonwealth of Virginia:

- Joseph G. Brady

They are authorized to legally notarize documents such as Power of Attorney, Bill of Sale, Will, Living Will, etc. Please check with the Post for an appointment. Be aware that under VA code the notary must acknowledge:

- Signer must personally appear before the notary
- Signer is positively identified
- Signer must affirm under oath the accuracy of the document.

# Acceptable Forms of Identification:

To be acceptable, the ID must be one of the following and current:

- Driver's license or State issued ID card
- U.S. Passport
- Foreign Passport (INS validated)
- Driver's license issued in Mexico or Canada
- U.S. Military ID Card.

We do not rely on Social Security cards or photo ID cards issued by non government entities. Under the law, the notary has the right to refuse, if he / she suspects anything may be false or wrong.

There were several groups represented for upcoming College Students and their parents. Students and parents stopped by to request Scholarship Brochures, ask about the programs and also ask about joining the VFW for the parents.
